> Raul Montesinos is a M.Sc. student focused on economic geology at the Colorado School of Mines, his research is based on high-sulfidation epithermal deposits hosted in siliciclastic sedimentary rocks in northern Peru. He hopes his research can provide more knowledge, which can be widely applied to the exploration of mineral deposits in siliciclastic terrains around the world. He holds a B.Sc. degree in geology from the Universidad Nacional del Altiplano, Puno, Peru. Prior to enrolling in the M.Sc. program, he worked for more than five years in mineral exploration in the central Andes. He plans to graduate at the end of 2023. Subsequently, he hopes to return to the industry applying new exploration criteria and techniques with a strong emphasis on blind and covered deposits.





Isabelle Harris is a PhD student in geology at Colorado School of Mines. Her dissertation studies critical mineral recovery from tailings centered on a case study of Flat, Alaska, a historic gold placer operation. Isabelle is from Newnan, Georgia and graduated from Furman University with a Bachelor of Science in 2022. Isabelle hopes to develop research and methods that support the achievement of a green and just energy transition. Her hobbies include cooking. anything with animals, and swimming in Clear Creek.

Erkan Ugur Aslan is a Geological Engineer pursuing his master's degree at the Colorado School of Mines, within the Mining Engineering Department. His thesis focuses on a comparative analysis of resource modeling techniques, specifically incorporating machine learning algorithms for point-shoot resource modeling. The aim of this project is to enhance the accuracy and reliability of resource models, benefiting the industry by reducing uncertainties and elevating valuation precision. This could ultimately minimize investment risks and contribute to safer underground operations.

In addition to his academic pursuits, he serves as a TA for advanced courses in Underground Mine Design and Senior Design within the Mining Engineering Department. Outside of academia and work, he is passionate for outdoor activities, exploring nature, and playing saxophone.


