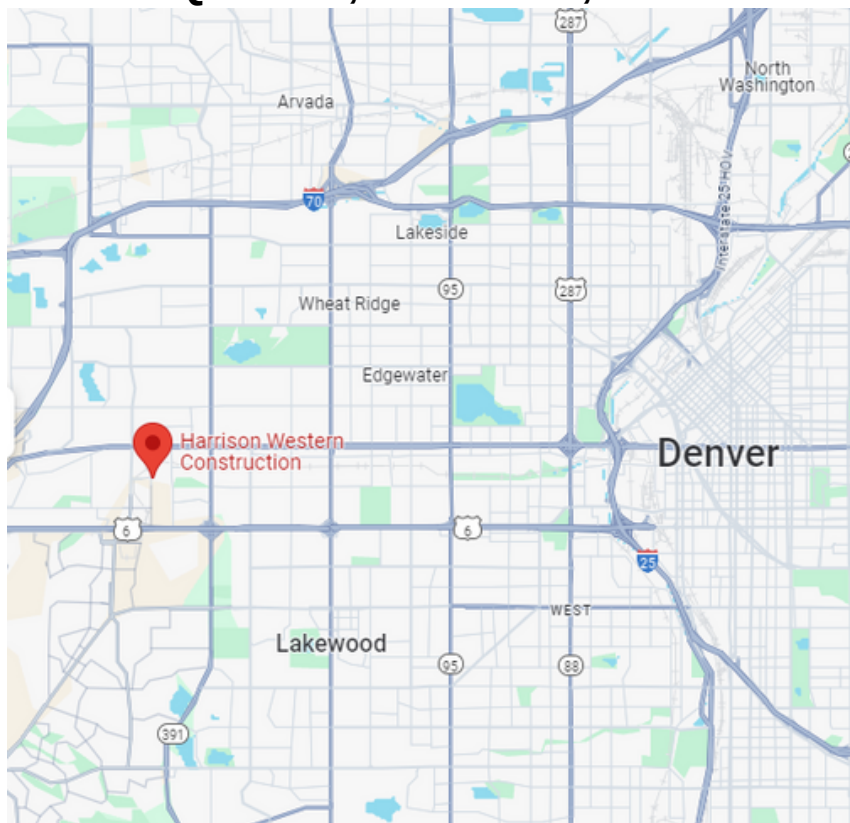

The Scenery of Bolivian Mining and Lithium

Dr. Juan Carlos Madeni

Colorado School of Mines



Biography

Dr. Madeni is an engineer, a materials scientist, an entrepreneur, and an educator. Most of his professional experience is in technological innovation in materials for the aerospace, energy, petroleum, microelectronics, and glass processing industries. He served as the R&D Director for Diamond Materials Technology, a Meyer Burger Company based in Switzerland, and is currently the Head for Metallurgy and Advanced Materials at Johns Manville, a Berkshire Hathaway Company. He co-founded Fidem LLC, energy and real estate, and Mine Water SRL, mining and mineral processing. Dr. Madeni is also an Adjunct Professor at the Colorado School of Mines and teaches in the Metallurgical and Materials Engineering Department. Some of his business skills include strategic planning, acquisitions, budgeting, business development, supervision, prioritization, innovation, and direction of short- and long-term projects.

Juan Carlos is a member and leader in different professional organizations, such as ASM International, TMS, EMCD, AMPP, and AWS from which he has received awards for his research, leadership, and service. He advocates for and promotes higher education in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM); he hosts students from elementary schools through college in the scientific laboratories where he works. Juan Carlos has served as the president of the Board of Directors at STEM Generation Inc., a non-profit organization. Dr. Madeni obtained a BSc and an MSc in Metallurgical and Materials Engineering, a PhD in Materials Science from the Colorado School of Mines, and a Leadership Diploma from the University of Denver.
