This is an educational field trip with emphasis on family participation and will be an exciting learning experience for all.

The transportation cost of this round-trip excursion is just \$25.00 for each participant. Overnight lodging and meals will be the responsibility of each individual.

## Tentative plans are as follows:

- Depart at 8:00 am from the Caltrain Station at 4<sup>th</sup> and Townsend in San Francisco, California, with an additional pick-up stop at the Kaiser Building, 300 Lakeside Drive, Oakland, California. Another stop will be made in Stockton, California, to pick-up SME-Sierra Nevada Section members, friends, teachers and rock hounds.
- Arrive in Bakersfield, California, for guided tour of the California Well Sample Repository at California State University, Bakersfield. Free core samples will be available.
- Arrive later in the afternoon in Tehachapi, California, for overnight stay. Preliminary estimate for lodging is approximately \$53.00, with queen bed and other amenities.
- Depart at 8:00 am to Boron, California. Take guided tour of the U.S. Borax Mine which includes
  all the free mineral specimens you can pack into a bag! U.S. Borax will provide lunch. Necessary
  safety items such as hard hats and safety glasses will also be provided.
- Arrive California Portland Cement Plant, Mojave, California, for guided tour and free specimens.
   All safety items will be provided by California Portland Cement Company.
- Depart for return trip to the Bay Area.
