Two Stage Restart Plan for the Castle Mountain Mine

The Castle Mountain heap leach gold mine in California produced more than one million ounces of gold from 1992 to 2004. Equinox Gold intends to put the mine back into production with the expectation of producing 2.8 million oz of gold and generating US \$865 million in after-tax cash flow over a 16-year mine life.
