After nine intensive days of classroom lectures coupled with nine days of field trips to various metals, industrial minerals, aggregates, and energy operations. the Colorado Mining Association Education Foundation (CMAEF) graduated 16 K-12 teachers and a museum curator from the 2013 All About Mining course (www.AllAboutMining.org) at the Colorado School of Mines.

CMAEF wishes to thank SME for providing a \$1500 grant to assist CMAEF with program expenses this year. Special financial contributions were also provided by the Woman's Auxiliary to the American Institute of Mining, Petroleum Metallurgical, and Engineers (WAAIME).
