

DIRECTIONS:

From St. Louis Area:

- Take I-44 West out of St. Louis Area to Cuba, MO.
- Take Exit 208, and turn Left (South) on Highway 19.
- Continue on Hwy 19 approximately 8.6 miles into Steelville.
- Turn Right to stay on Highway 19 in the town of Steelville.
- Continue another 10 miles to the Highway 49 Junction in Cherryville.
- Turn left on Highway 49 and continue for about 5 miles.
- Turn right to stay on Highway 49.
- Continue for another 10 miles into the town of Viburnum and turn Left on Highway Y.
- About 2 miles down Highway Y, turn Right into the Viburnum Golf and Country Club.



For those cutting across from Highway 67 or Highway 21, take Highway 32 West toward Viburnum. Turn right (North) on Highway 49 in Bixby. On the north side of the town of Viburnum, turn Right onto Highway Y. About 2 miles down Highway Y, turn Right into the Viburnum Golf and Country Club.

From Salem Area

Take Hwy 32 East/Hwy 72 East to Bixby. Turn Left (North) on Highway 49 and continue into town of Viburnum. On the North side of town, turn Right on Highway Y. About 2 miles down Highway Y, turn Right into the Viburnum Golf and Country Club.
