Gregory F. Sutton Greg Sutton is the General Manager – Mining Operations for Missouri Cobalt in Fredericktown, MO. He oversees surface mining operations at the Madison Mine Site and is planning and building the new underground Cobalt/Nickel/Copper mine there as well. In 1988, Greg earned a Bachelors of Science Degree in Mining Engineering from the University of Missouri – Rolla, now Missouri University of Science and Technology. 
